1. Select the overall color (like yellow) then look thru your choices. Once you've selected the color, provide us with the paint code it will be something like SW1234.
2. What type of surface are you painting?
Will paint be applied to a drywall surface or concrete or brick/block or wood trim?
If the surface is something else, explain what it is
3. Do you want the paint to have a shiny/glossy finish or a more flat (satin)look.
Usually a non-shiny finish wears better in high traffic areas such as schools and community centers.
4. How much do you need? – to develop your estimate, tell us how large an area you're painting – length x height (i.e. the square footage),
This doesn't have to be an exact measurement, just a close estimate.
